Scholarship Description & Criteria:

The Cincinnati-Eastside Rotary Club is an organization of business, civic and professional community leaders whose purpose is to promote, foster and encourage the ideals of "SERVICE ABOVE SELF." Rotary is an international organization with over 32,000 clubs in more than 165 countries.

This year the Cincinnati-Eastside Rotary Club will award five (5) \$1,000 scholarships to graduating seniors attending any Clermont or Eastern Hamilton high schools (including home schooled). The scholarship funds must be used to help defray college expenses.

The scholarships will be awarded at a regularly scheduled luncheon meeting of the club. The time and date of the luncheon will be announced later.

Strong emphasis is given to candidates who exemplify "SERVICE ABOVE SELF" by participating in community service projects and special consideration is given to candidates who are active in Interact Club. The applicants must meet the following qualifications for these scholarships:

- Be a graduating senior at an above listed high school (including home-schooled students)
- Must be accepted and enrolled to an accredited community college, college or university
- Have demonstrated involvement in school activities (example: Interact Club, etc.)

• Have demonstrated significant involvement in community service activities (minimum of 30 hours documented) (example: Interact Club service project participant)

• Continue a passion for community service at your higher education institution

• Completed a Cincinnati-Eastside Rotary Club scholarship application no later than May 16, 2025.

• Attend Scholarship Reception at Ivy Hills Country Club on June 4, 2025.
